Montgomery Martin Contractors, LLC Earns Certified Commercial Contractor Designation



Underscored somewhat by the presence of Coach Josh Pastner, WTCABC recognized an achievement for one of our contractors and a milestone for the chapter. Montgomery Martin Contractors, LLC was recognized as the chapter's inaugural Certified Commercial Contractor (CCC). The CCC designation recognizes

contractors of any size who excel in the areas of:

- professional development & continuing education
- jobsite safety
- a drug-free work environment
- high-quality employee benefits
- quality construction & customer satisfaction
- community involvement.

Those desiring to receive the designation must complete a lengthy application that asks numerous questions about the areas listed above. The application is then reviewed by a committee to determine if the applicant received the minimum number of points required. Once awarded the designation, CCCs must complete at least 40 hours of continuing education annually and reapply every three years.
